Spectators: Parents are welcome to watch all on-court aspects of camp. Camp sessions will take place at the [Madtown Volleyball Facility](#), the Nicholas Johnson Pavilion, and the Nicholas Recreation Center.

Parking and Entrance Information: For those at Madtown, parking is available on the street outside the facility and at the discretion of the attendee. Please enter through the facility's main entrance. For those on-campus, hourly parking is available in Lot 46, one block away from the Kohl Center area. Lot 46 is a short 5 minute walk to the Nicholas Johnson Pavilion. Parking is at the discretion of the attendee as parking may be limited on campus.

Positions Camp II (If applicable): Our Serving Camp that day will be held directly after Positions camp with campers re-checking in after their closing. Please be aware that there is no dinner provided, so we recommend bringing a snack for between the two camps. Check-in should be quick since campers will have already received their camp t-shirt/water bottle during the Positions Camp.

Camp Store: A camp store will be open during check-in and check-out for campers and their families to purchase Wisconsin Volleyball apparel and volleyball-related gear! Credit cards are required for purchase.
